Happy Summer, Friends!

Once again, we're in the middle of the dog days of summer at Straydog, where we work hard to keep the dogs and staff safe and hydrated during the brutal Texas heat. Some of the safety measures that we take are to give our dogs kiddie pools to cool off in, and bring the most vulnerable dogs into a temperature controlled space in one of the three small buildings that we currently have.

There is one BIG thing that is different this year — the knowledge that next summer will be better because of the huge construction project that was begun in May! When work is completed in autumn, we'll have two large, beautiful, temperature-controlled buildings to house 80 of our 160+ dogs. You can read about our Better Life Campaign and see the progress on pages 5 & 6. One of our supporters said the buildings look like the Ark! We like to think of them that way. They will save our dogs from weather extremes, and provide a better life for the length of time they're at Straydog.

This is a marvelous change for sure, but sadly, there are two things that have not changed for Straydog: *the need to help homeless animals and the money it takes to do this.*

As a no-kill rescue and sanctuary we can't take them all in, but we do offer an outreach program, whereby we help fund spay/neuter surgeries and medical treatment for dogs that will be fostered by good samaritans. We also assist in promoting these dogs for adoption by posting on our channels. Within the last few months we have helped 5 dogs find their forever homes this way.

Straydog continues to do its part, but our operational budget is always strained. We implore you to help during this time of crisis and give what you can to help us continue our mission. We're making a difference, one dog at a time, and cannot do it without you. Thank you so much for believing in our work and for continuing to support our residents and mission at Straydog.

Thanks to your generous support, we are able to keep helping our residents find their forever families. Here are a few of their stories.

The need is now.

Since 2022, euthanasia rates have been rising, financial support for shelters has been declining, and the need for rescue work is greater than we've ever seen.

As a 100% no-kill shelter, we are careful to balance the heart-breaking stories with the happy tails, because if the sad ones are hard for us to hold, we know how they would impact our communities. All too often we live the shock and sadness that this work generates. This year has been more challenging than ever.

In a recent call to rescue a couple of dogs, we found 20 dogs in need. Most of them were fragile, newborn puppies, abandoned and left behind to survive without food, water, or protection. And that's just one rescue. That's why it's so important that we take the time to remember why we do this work; it's the happy stories and loving forever homes that our deserving rescues find.

A BETTER LIFE

This Spring, Straydog enthusiastically broke ground for its two, badly needed new shelter buildings.

The buildings will provide safe, temperature controlled, indoor housing for 80 rescues, especially important for our senior dogs and dogs with medical needs.

The new space will protect our residents from the dangerous extremes of Texas weather. Each of the 6 x 7-foot luxury indoor suites includes access to individual, large, outdoor runs. Once outside, the dogs can enjoy basking in the sun or relaxing on their own private patios, safe and happy.

The goal of our A Better Life Campaign is to provide an improved quality of life for **all of** our rescues.

Since the new buildings will only support 80 of our 160+ residents, there is still much work to be done for the rest of our campus. This includes regrading and leveling the rest of the grounds, rebuilding outdoor dog houses, relocating outdoor kennels, renovating space for socialization, and improving laundry and food prep areas to save time and maximize care.
